What is **Entry to Employment?**

E2E is designed to help young people develop their motivation and confidence, personal effectiveness and basic and key skills.

E2E gives learners a range of opportunities to gain vocational knowledge, skills and understanding. The aim is that they will progress into a Modern Apprenticeship, further learning and/or a job.

A range of qualifications are available, including First Aid, Health and Safety, Food Hygiene and CLAIT.

Learners receive EMA plus expenses and bonuses. The programme is tailored to individual needs, but is usually between 16 and 30 hours a week, for a duration appropriate to them.
